Brighton parents' warning: Babies under one hit hardest by meningitis and septicaemia.

Toby & Caroline Berryman

Toby and Caroline's son Zachary died from meningococcal meningitis and septicaemia in January 2005 aged just 15 months. Toby ran Edinburgh marathon 06 & 07 and raffled impressive prizes for Foundation June 07. They have since had a daughter, Bertie.

Said Toby: "Our son Zachary died from Group B meningitis in January 2005. He was only 15 months old. We couldn't believe how quickly the disease took him from us, just 12 hours after he first became ill. It's vitally important to be aware of the symptoms of meningitis and septicaemia in infants as they're 38 times more likely to get meningitis than older children and adults, that's why we're supporting meningitis awareness week."
